Welcome to Season 2013

We have a number of new families already with us this year so to each of you, welcome and we hope that your stay with us is a long and satisfying one. For those of you returning again this year, welcome back – it's great to see a lot of the same friendly faces from previous years returning again.

Don't forget that 2013 is our 45th season fielding teams in E&DJSA and we plan to have a few "celebratory" experiences this year. Stay tuned for details.

Please remember if you do need to park on the road there are a number of parking restrictions around the club, including in front of the ambulance entry gate (Liverpool Crescent) and the bus stops (Gloucester Avenue). During the playing season we are fortunate to have use of the Salisbury East High School car park on Gloucester Avenue, where you are encouraged to park to reduce the hazards of street parking.

Bear in mind that the roads in the area are 50km/hr except when children are present. During this time they are restricted to the legislated lower limit.

While it is easy to get excited during soccer games please remember that soccer is for the children to enjoy and, as such, the club will not tolerate abusive behaviour from spectators. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with the Association's rules and our Code of Conduct in the coming weeks.

E&DJSA's association rule that children's soccer is an alcohol free zone except where clubs have licensed facilities. This means that alcohol cannot be brought to, or consumed, at Davey Oval during either training or games.

As a club we are run entirely by volunteers and it takes all of us to make it work efficiently. Please participate in your duties in the canteen or on the BBQ during game days. There are also a number of other jobs that must be done on game day so don't be afraid to ask if you can help. This year we will also be looking for people to participate in a couple of sub-committees – especially around Fundraising and 45year Celebrations – so if you think you can spare some time for these please let us know.

Playing Sunday

- Under 16 - players born in 1997 or 1998 (team is currently full)
- Under 14 - players born in 1999 or 2000

Playing Saturday

- Under 13 - players born in 2000 (team is currently full)
- Under 12 - players born in 2001 or 2002
- Under 10 - players born in 2003 or 2004
- Under 8 - players born in 2005
- Under 7 - players born in 2006
- Under 6 - players born in 2007 or 2008

New registrations require:

1. A photocopy of the players blue CAFHS book page or birth certificate/passport confirming the players date of birth. The original must be produced as well so that the copy can be signed as "original sighted",
2. For Under 9 and above age groups - a passport size photo no smaller than 3.5cm x 4.5cms with the child's name and date of birth written on the back of the photo.
3. Deposit of \$30 - (full fee is \$160).

Uniform News

All players require socks (Bottle Green - available from Sports Power or similar) and shorts (which can be purchased through the club for a cost of \$20).

Order sheets for shorts will be issued soon. All shorts **must be paid in full** prior to receiving your order.

Reminder : Don't leave it until the last minute to check last years uniform

Clubrooms

Noticeboards along the hallway enable us to display information about SEJSC's history and the current SEJSC & EDJSA policies. If you have a spare 5 minutes please drop into the clubrooms and familiarise yourself.

We also need your help to keep the clubrooms tidy and clean. Here's a reminder of the rules:

- **An adult should accompany all children in the clubrooms.**
- **All rubbish must be placed in the bins provided.**
- **Soccer boots are banned inside the clubroom (carpeted area)**
- **Ball games are banned inside the Change and Team Rooms.**
- **Children are not permitted in the equipment room.**

Training Requirements

Please make sure that your child:

1. Wears **SHINPADS (under SOCKS or long pants) - this is mandatory**

Without them they will be unable to train or play

2. Wears **SOCCER BOOTS** for ball work. (Check your coach for exceptions)
3. Have their own **BOTTLE OF WATER.**
4. Brings along a **JACKET, JUMPER or COAT** to all training sessions.
5. Wears a cap (peaked) to protect their face during the warmer months.

Hot Weather Policy

Note please:

Due to EDJSA hot weather policy we cannot hold training or games when the weather forecast for the training day is **32 degrees or over for the Elizabeth area.** This means training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature is **32 degrees or over, as reported on the previous days nightly news.** For full details of the policy please refer to the Policy Board in the Hallway.
